CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY

- General/Unreserved/General-EWS candidates who have secured at least 55% marks (without rounding off) in Master's Degree or equivalent examination from universities/institutions recognized by UGC is eligible for this Test. The Other Backward Classes (OBC) belonging to Non-Creamy Layer/ Scheduled Caste (SC)/ Scheduled Tribe (ST)/ Persons with Disability (PwD)/ Third gender category candidates who have secured at least 50% marks (without rounding off) in Master's degree or equivalent examination are eligible for this Test.
- Candidates who are pursuing their Master's degree or equivalent course or candidates who have appeared for their qualifying Master's degree (final year) examination and whose result is still awaited or candidates whose qualifying examinations have been delayed may also apply for this test. However, such candidates will be admitted provisionally and shall be considered eligible for award of eligibility only after they have passed their Master's Degree or equivalent examination with at least 55% marks (50% marks in case of OBC-NCL/ SC / ST / PwD / Third gender category candidates). Such candidates must complete their Master's degree or equivalent examination within two years from the date of SET result with required percentage of marks, failing which they shall be treated as disqualified.
- Candidates belonging to the Third gender category are eligible to draw the same relaxation in fee and Eligibility Criteria for SET as are available to SC/ST/PwD categories. The subject-wise qualifying

cut-offs for this category would be the lowest among those for SC / ST / PwD / OBCNCL / General-EWS categories in the corresponding subject.

- Candidates are required to appear in subject of their post-graduation only. In case the subject of a candidate is not included in the list of SET subjects, the candidate may appear in UGC NET/UGC-CSIR NET, which is held twice a year.

VALIDITY

The SET certificate is valid for that particular State only. The validity of the certificate shall be forever. Recruitment to the post of lecturer/ Assistant Professor may be made from among the SET qualified candidates by universities/ colleges/ Recruitment Agencies as per their prescribed procedures, Rules & Regulations.

SCHEME OF TEST

Pattern of Examination:

The test will consist of two papers (I and II). Both the papers will consist of objective type multiple choice questions (MCQ). There will be no break between papers.

Paper	Marks	Number of Questions	MCQ	Total Duration
I	100	50	The Questions in paper I intends to assess the teaching / research aptitude of the candidate. It will primarily be designed to test reasoning ability, reading comprehension, divergent thinking and general awareness of the candidate.	03 hours (180 minutes) without any break (Duration of Paper-I and II are one hour and two hours respectively). All the questions are compulsory
II	200	100	This is based on the subject selected by the candidate and will assess subject knowledge of the candidate.	

Medium of Question paper:

- The medium of question paper shall be in English & Hindi only. However, the language paper will be in the concerned language (medium) only.
- In case of any ambiguity in translation/construction of a question in the exam, its English version shall be treated as final and the decision of university shall be final in this regard.

Marking Scheme:

- Each question carries 02 (two) marks.
- For each correct response, candidate will get 02 (two) marks.
- There is no negative marking for incorrect response.
- No marks will be given for questions un-answered/un-attempted.
- To answer a question, the candidate needs to choose one option as correct option. If a question is found to be incorrect/ambiguous or has multiple correct answers, only those candidates who have attempted the question and chosen one of the correct answers would be given the Credit.
- If a question is found to be incorrect and the Question is dropped, for any reason, then two marks (+2) will be awarded to all those who have appeared in this paper/ Exam.
